

Mill River Art Gallery (MRAG) Entry Information:

If you would like your artwork/photography to be considered for display in the Mill River Art Gallery, please read the following information carefully and complete the application form. By submitting an application form you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.

Each gallery is hung for 2 months. Each show we hold is for 1 Artist at a time to showcase their work (unless otherwise specified). On the last day of gallery dates your artwork must be picked up.

How many works of art can be submitted?

The number of pieces are subject to change depending on size of the pieces. MRAG reserves the right to eliminate pieces if the gallery looks crowded.

What type of art can be submitted?

All media that is able to be hung on the wall is accepted. MRAG reserves the right to decline art that cannot be conveniently displayed.

You will need to submit at least 4 photos of your art before moving forward, once selected MRAG must see all work a minimum of 1 week prior to gallery hanging.

Guidelines:

All artwork presented for exhibition is selected by the gallery coordinators based on the following criteria.

- The work should be recognizable as a work of art by an average customer.
 - The work should not display segmented body parts as primary content.
 - The work should be engaging and of interest to our average customers.
 - All exhibits portraying overt sexual, pornographic, or violent connotations will be rejected.
- Exceptions to the above criteria must be approved on a case by case basis

How to prepare your art

Printing of photographs are supplied by Ross Imaging Center on standard luster photo paper. All two dimensional art mugs be mounted/matted, framed, and under glass/ plexiglass and be properly wired to be ready to hang (This is a great video that describes how to wire an art piece <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LBnqLeEil2k>) The maximum size piece we will accept is 30inx40in. Three dimensional artwork must be wired also. We do not allow for freestanding podiums.

Liability
